Time flies by, and it's already been a year and a half since we moved here to Vienna. It has been a very busy time, but we have also made a lot of progress. The church is growing, and has just experienced a relaunch of sorts, along with a new name - "Freikirche Forum Wien" (look for us on facebook). Brenda has been doing great work preparing crafts and lessons for our kids classes, and has revolutionized the way we minister to children. The former pastor's wife has started a youth group that meets twice a month after service and they take trips to christian events. The young generation is on fire,

But thank God! He has made us his captives and continues to lead us along in Christ's triumphal procession.

Now he uses us to spread the knowledge of Christ everywhere, like a sweet perfume

loving God and serving in the church - with more enthusiasm than most adults!

Andre moved up to middle school in the summer and ended up in a chaotic school, where he has been attacked and beaten on several occasions purely for being American. We would like to move him to a christian charter school, so we are asking you to consider partnering with us to help us afford the reasonable monthly fee of €250.

Good news! Thanks in part to some generous gifts from you - our partners, we were able to buy a 3-year old french minivan in great condition for €5.500 - what a deal! We still owe €2.000 on the car, so please pray for us, and see if this may be ground for you to sow into. We do use the vehicle a lot to drive around Austria, minister in churches, teach Rhema classes, visit people in hospital and at home, and so on.
